9-1-1 Emergency Reporting Service

1. The Commission received an application by Vidéotron Télécom ltée (VTL), dated 21 February 2005, for approval of item 600, VTL 9-1-1 Emergency Reporting Service (ERS), under Part F of its General Tariff of Interconnection.
2. The Commission received no comments with respect to the application.
3. The Commission notes that the VTL 9-1-1 Emergency Reporting Service tariff provisions are similar to those found in other approved competitive local exchange carrier tariffs. Moreover, in the absence of a signed agreement, VTL could now rely on the tariff to define its relationship with a municipality in terms of ERS.
4. However, the Commission notes that the English version of item 600.5.1(4) should read as follows:
 4. The characteristics and reliability of the 9-1-1 service provided by the 9-1-1 Service Provider to the extent that VTL's participation in the provision of 9-1-1 ERS is dependent on the 9-1-1 service provided by the 9-1-1 Service Provider.
5. The Commission **approves subject to the above change** VTL's application. The revisions take effect as of the date of this Order.
6. VTL is to issue revised tariff pages forthwith to reflect this change.
