CKXT-DT Toronto and its transmitter at Ottawa – Technical change

1. The Commission **approves** the application by Sun TV Company to amend the broadcasting licence for the English-language transitional digital television programming undertaking CKXT-DT Toronto in order to change the channel of its Ottawa transmitter from 62C to 20C, and to change the authorized contours of the same transmitter, by increasing the average effective radiated power from 4,600 watts to 5,100 watts.
2. The licensee indicated that the changes are the result of it sharing the Ontario Educational Communications Authority's (TVOntario's) antenna instead of installing a separate new antenna system.
3. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
