Licensing of new radio stations to serve Gimli and Winnipeg Beach and new transmitter in Arborg – Correction

1. The Commission hereby corrects *Licensing of new radio stations to serve Gimli and Winnipeg Beach and new transmitter in Arborg*, Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2010-65, 10 February 2010 (Broadcasting Decision 2010-65). In that decision, the date by which a request for an extension of time for the commencement of operations must be approved by the Commission was erroneously indicated as 10 February 2010.
2. Accordingly, the paragraph relating to the issuance of a licence in Appendix 2 to Broadcasting Decision 2010-65 is replaced by the following:

The Commission will only issue the licence and the licence will only be effective at such time as:

- the applicant submits, within 90 days of the date of this decision, an amendment to its application proposing the use of an FM frequency other than 93.7 MHz (channel 229A) and related technical parameters that are acceptable to both the Commission and the Department of Industry (the Department). This amended application will form part of a public process;
- pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued; and
- the applicant has informed the Commission in writing that it is prepared to commence operations. The undertaking must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 24 months from the date of this decision, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before 10 February 2012. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted at least 60 days before this date.
