Application by **Haliburton Broadcasting Group Inc.** (Haliburton) for authority to acquire the assets of the English-language commercial radio programming undertakings CFLZ-FM Niagara Falls and CKEY-FM Fort Erie and its transmitter CKEY-FM-1 St. Catharines, from Niagara Radio Group Inc.

The applicant also requests new broadcasting licences to continue the operation of the undertakings under the same terms and conditions as those in effect under the current licences.

Haliburton is controlled by Mr. Christopher Grossman through his ownership and control of Beaumaris Group Inc., Haliburton's controlling shareholder.

Based on the terms of the Asset Purchase and Sale Agreement dated 29 November 2010, the purchase price is \$5.5 million.

The applicant has proposed a tangible benefits package of \$330,000, to be spent over a seven-year period.
