1. Further to Broadcasting Notice of Consultation 2014-85, the Commission received a joint letter from various broadcasters and broadcasting distribution undertakings¹ requesting an extension of time to provide comments in the current proceeding.
2. Having considered the request, the Commission announces that the deadline to submit comments for this proceeding has been extended to **17 April 2014**. The Commission notes that this amended deadline does not change its proposal to require the broadcasting industry to distribute emergency alert messages received from the National Alert Aggregation and Dissemination System by no later than 31 December 2014.
