Renaming of Spike TV as Paramount Network on the *List of non-Canadian programming services and stations authorized for distribution*

1. In *Distribution of Spike TV by broadcasting distribution undertakings*, Broadcasting Public Notice CRTC 2005-9, 27 January 2005, the Commission approved the addition of Spike TV: The First Network for Men, a non-Canadian English-language men's lifestyle programming service, to the *List of non-Canadian programming services and stations authorized for distribution* (the list). This service is operated by the international media company Viacom Inc.
2. In a letter to the Commission dated 23 August 2017, Viacom Inc.'s Canadian representative Jessop & Proulx LLP indicated that effective 18 January 2018, the service would change its name to Paramount Network and confirmed that the nature of the service would remain unchanged.
