Call for licence renewal applications – Correction

Submission of renewal applications for broadcasting licences of radio stations expiring on 31 August 2023 – Simplified renewal process

The Commission corrects the appendix to *Call for licence renewal applications – Submission of renewal applications for broadcasting licences of radio stations expiring on 31 August 2023 – Simplified renewal process*, Broadcasting Notice of Consultation CRTC 2022-151, 10 June 2022 (Broadcasting Notice of Consultation 2022-151).
