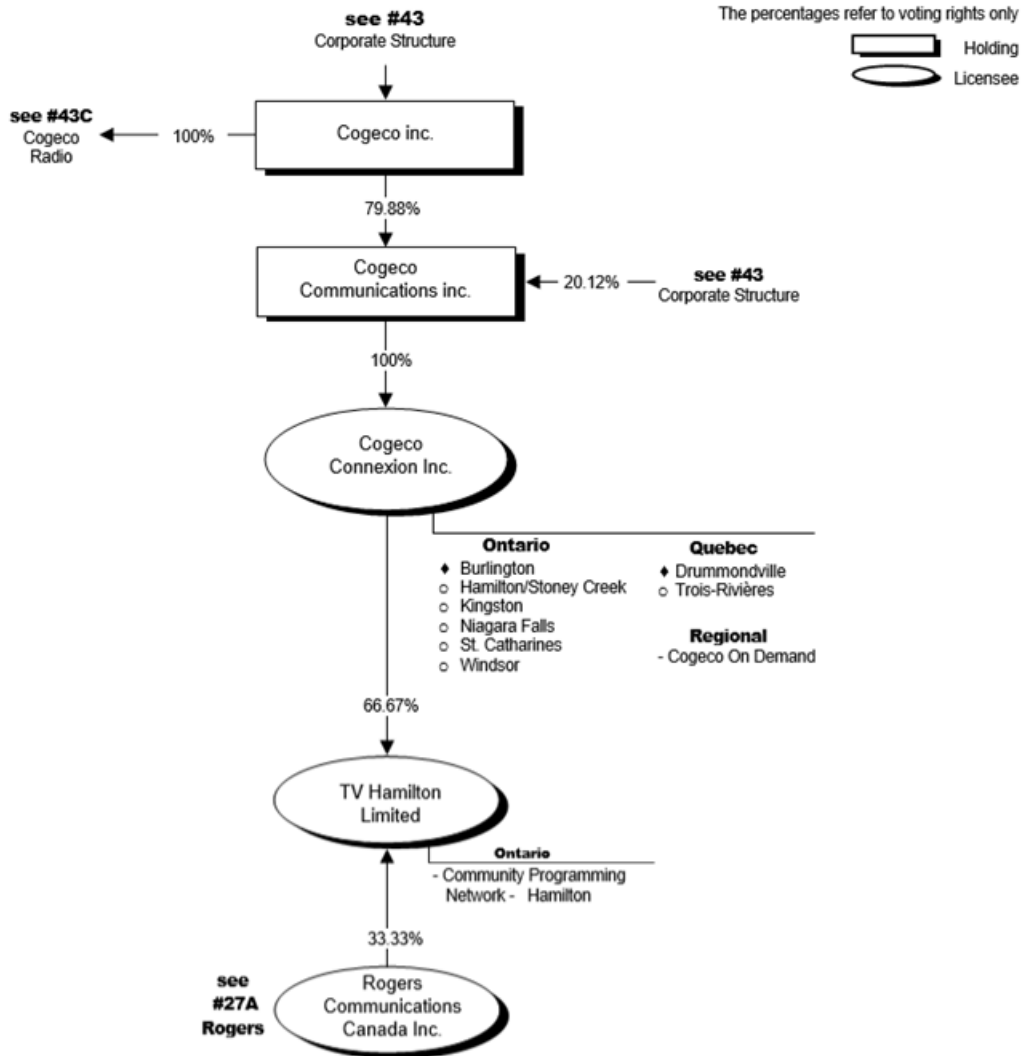

Cogeco inc. holds 79.88% of Cogeco Communications inc. See Chart 43 for the ownership of the remaining 20.12%.

Cogeco Communications inc. holds 100% of Cogeco Connexion Inc.

Cogeco Connexion Inc. is the licensee of regional broadcasting licences for terrestrial broadcasting distribution undertakings (BDUs) in Ontario and Quebec. Cogeco Connexion Inc. is also licensee of a regional on demand service known as Cogeco On Demand serving Quebec and Ontario.

The Ontario regional licence includes the terrestrial BDUs serving:

- Burlington
- Hamilton/Stoney Creek
- Kingston
- Niagara Falls
- St. Catharines
- Windsor

The Quebec regional licence includes the terrestrial BDUs serving:

- Drummondville
- Trois-Rivières

Cogeco Connexion Inc. also holds 66.67% of TV Hamilton Limited, licensee of a community programming network serving Hamilton. Rogers Communications Canada Inc., a licensee owned by Rogers (see chart 27A Rogers), holds the remaining 33.33% interest in TV Hamilton.

Cogeco also owns exempt terrestrial BDUs.
