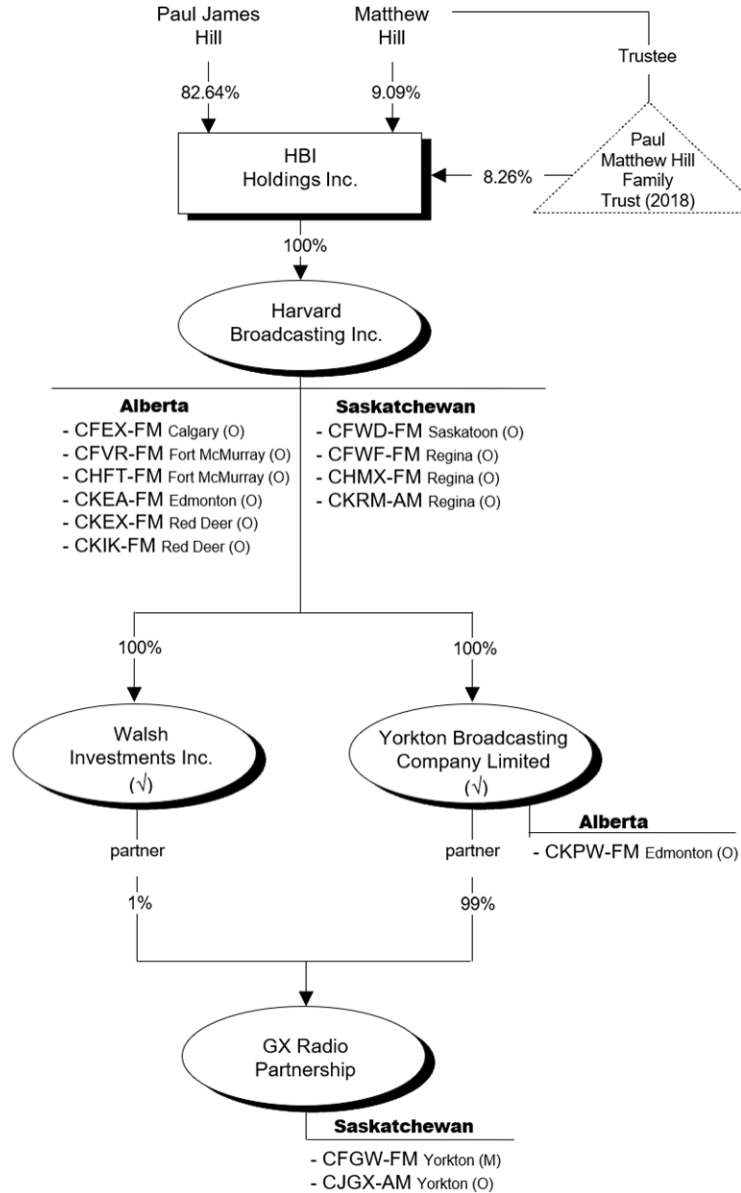

CRTC 2013-593 – approved the acquisition by Harvard Broadcasting Inc. of the assets of CHFT-FM Fort McMurray from Newcap Inc.

CRTC 2015-573 – approved the acquisition by Harvard Broadcasting Inc. of the assets of CKIK-FM Red Deer from L.A. Radio Group Inc.

Administrative Decision – 2016-08-08 – approved a multi-step corporate reorganization resulting in the transfer of all the issued and outstanding shares in the capital of Harvard Broadcasting Inc. to HBI Holdings Inc., a corporation whollyowned by Paul James Hill; the amalgamation of 1475435 Alberta Ltd. and Yorkton Broadcsting Company Limited (Yorkton) to continue as Yorkton and; the transfer of 24% of the interest in the GX Radio Partnership from Walsh Investments Inc. to Yorkton.
